Emergency Organization	Role
District of Ucluelet Emergency Planning Committee - Paid & Volunteer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Develop the emergency plans for the District of Ucluelet including- preparation, response, and recovery • Management of Incidents via the EOC
Emergency Social Services (ESS) -Volunteer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provides primary services (food, shelter, basic personal care) to evacuees of small and large emergencies and disasters for up 72 hours.
Ucluelet Volunteer Fire Brigade (UVFB) - Volunteer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fire Fighting • Road Rescue • Community education
Search and Rescue (SAR) -Volunteer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Search and rescue for missing people
BC Ambulance (BCAS) -Paid	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On-scene and Pre-hospital medical care • Medical transport
Coast Guard -Paid and Volunteer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Aids to Navigation, • Waterways Management, • Marine Communications, • Environmental Response
Rangers -Volunteer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provides a military presence in remote, isolated, and coastal communities
Police/RCMP -Paid	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Crime control • Community service • Order maintenance
Victim Services -Volunteer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Emotional Support • Referrals (Professional support organizations) • Information and practical assistance
