The Board of Variance is a panel consisting of three persons who are principally responsible for hearing and making decisions on requests for minor variances, or relaxations to the siting, size and dimension provisions in the zoning bylaws.

Candidates will be excellent communicators, have critical decision making skills and understand the implications of their decisions on the property under application, adjacent properties and the broader community. Experience with design, construction, urban design, architecture or planning is an asset but not required. The board typically meets once a month after regular office hours.

Deadline for submitting an expression of interest is 4 p.m. February 15, 2012. Successful candidates will be appointed by Council on February 23, 2012. Only successful candidates will be notified.
